### Meeting Topic:

## UNDERSTANDING THE GOSPEL: A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD

**1 Peter 2:9-10** *But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.*

**:10** *Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.*

While Paul exhorts us in Philippians 2: to have the same attitude as Jesus – who came as a servant – and as such we are to serve God and each other – we do not do as paupers or slaves. We do so as sons and daughters, but more than that we do so as a Royal Priesthood.
