Meeting Topic:

THE GOSPEL: ARE WE TRULY CONVINCED OF THE GOOD NEWS?

Paul had a real passion for the Gospel – he didn’t ever want to see it distorted or weakened – because he knew it alone had the power to save.

In our series on Understanding the Gospel we have explored various truths such as:

Forgiveness, acceptance, new creation reality, holiness, righteousness, our union with Jesus and that we are now Royal Priests. These great truths, when understood release us into the wide expanses of the freedom of the Gospel.

2 Cor 13:5 Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?

Paul’s challenge to the Corinthians was whether they truly held to the Gospel. This raises questions for all of us, not whether we are saved or not, but are we living in the fullness of what Jesus died to give us.
